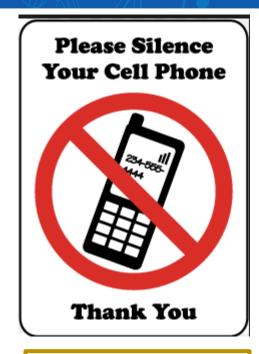

#### LET'S LEARN MORE!!!

As Peck (1978), cited in Celce-Murcia (2001), states "Activities need to be child centered and communication should be authentic. This means that children are listening or speaking about something that interests them, for their own reasons, and not merely because a teacher has asked them to" (1978, p.139). Also, Peck (1978), cited in CelceMurcia (2001, p.139), outlines some points that the teacher should consider in the activities: a focus on meaning and value, not correctness; a focus on collaboration and social development; the provision of a rich context, and teaching the four skills through a variety of activities.

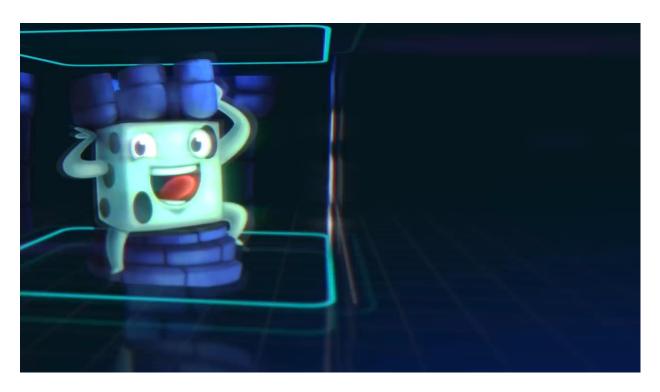

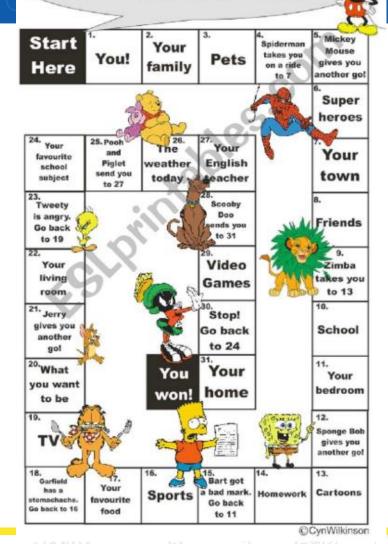
