



1º ACTIVITY - Planning lessons for a reading class

A principal atividade de uma aula de leitura é os alunos lerem textos

Alguns professores têm o hábito de falar sobre leitura, mas apenas poucos desses professores realmente fazem com que seus alunos leiam na sala de aula (exceto para testá-los). Toda aula deveria ter um tempo dedicado à leitura propriamente dita, no qual a escrita, a conversação e a compreensão oral deveriam ser deixadas de lado.

A ênfase aqui é que os professores deveriam fazer os alunos lerem de fato durante as aulas, e não apenas falar ou escrever sobre leitura: eles (alunos e professores) deveriam praticar o ato físico de ler durante a aula. Obviamente, aulas integradas acontecerão quando o professor apresentar oralmente as atividades que antecedem a leitura e poderão também ser dadas algumas atividades que incluam escrita, comunicação oral e compreensão auditiva.





1º ACTIVITY - Planning lessons for a reading class

As atividades e os exercícios refletem a natureza interativa e intencional com ênfase em tarefas da leitura real (previsão, hipótese e revisão de idéias sobre o que foi lido)

Cada aula deve ter alguns objetivos específicos.
Como, por exemplo, fazer com que os alunos façam previsões em suas mais variadas formas: prever a história de acordo com o título, prever o parágrafo de acordo com a frase inicial, prever o final da história após ler a introdução, e assim por diante.

O Apêndice 1 é um exemplo de uma aula que tem um foco e um objetivo específicos como:


Foco Lingüístico	Leitura
Tópico	Esporte
Objetivos	Ensinar os alunos a ler rapida- mente e a encontrar a idéia principal do trecho.
Conhecimento Prévio	Os alunos aprenderam a localizar informações através da leitura e a encontrar a frase principal em cada parágrafo. Esta aula é para praticar o aumento da velocidade deles sem ter que ler procurando detalhes ou ler rapidamente para obter informações.
Materiais	Material de leitura - artigo retirado de um livro sobre esportes, retroprojetor e quadro branco.




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SEASONS



Down:

- 1. bright because of light from the sun
- a tall plant that has a wooden trunk and branches that grow from its upper part
- 7. produced by a plant

FACT FILE: Seasons

FUN FACTS:

- When it is summer in the north it is winter in the south.
- At the North and South Pole there are only two seasons.
- In tropical places near the Earth's equator there are two seasons: a 'wet' season and a 'dry' season.

In many places the weather changes during the year. These changes are called seasons. In the north and south there are four seasons in a year. Each season brings changes that are important for plants and animals that live in different parts of the world.



Spring starts when the day and night are the same length. The weather gets warmer and sunnier. Trees and plants start to grow. Many animals have their babies in spring.

Summer begins on the longest day of the year. In the north this is on 21 June. Summer is usually the warmest and sunniest time of the year. Fruit grows on trees and plants. Young animals grow bigger and stronger.





Autumn starts when the day and night are the same length again. During autumn, the leaves change colour and fall from the trees. Some animals collect food before winter comes.

Winter begins on the shortest day of the year. In the north this is on 21 December. The weather is colder and in some places there is lots of snow. Plants and trees stop growing. Some animals, like bats and bears, find places to hide and sleep. This is called hibernation.








