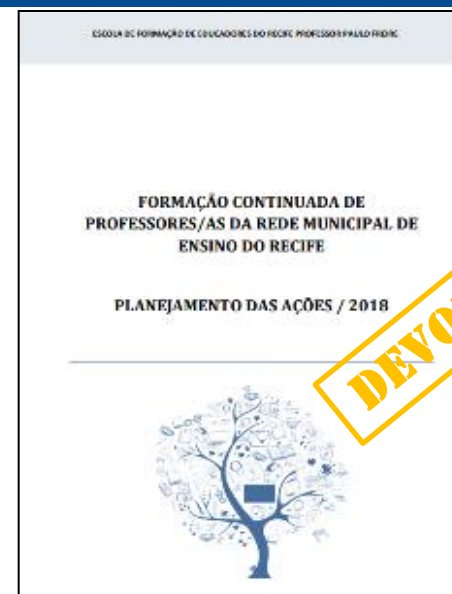

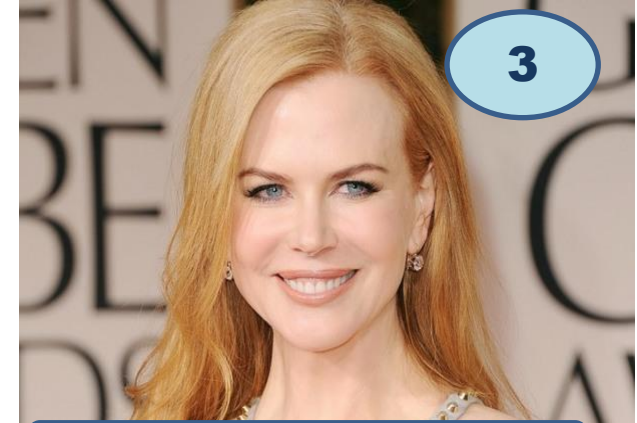

Acquiring strategies for culture learning!

Web quest is a great way to promote cultural awareness: EFL teachers can follow these instructions:students

The main difference of Australian English pronunciation for the other variations is the way the vowel sounds are emitted.

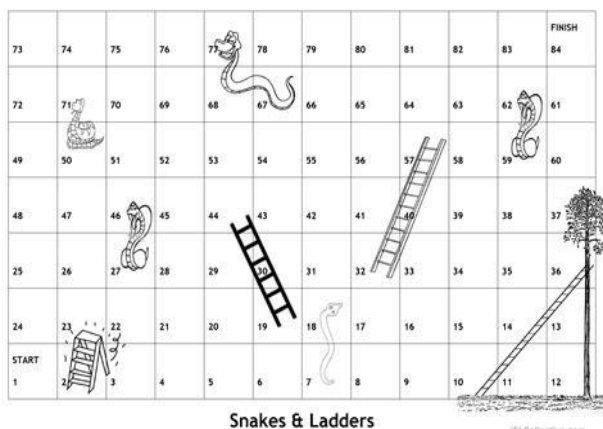
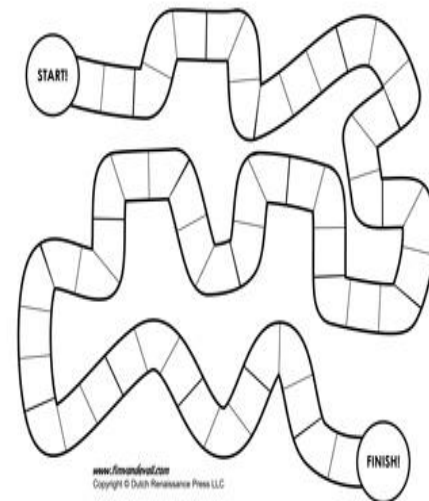
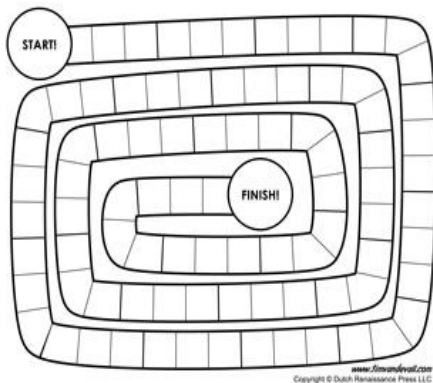
It is common for Australians to eliminate various sounds of words, especially at the beginning or at the end.

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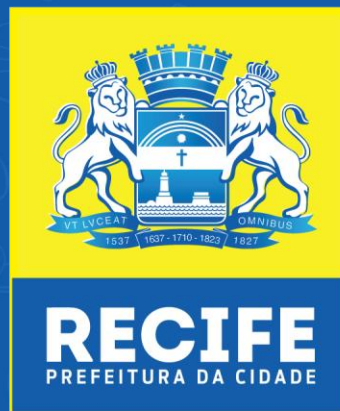
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
